This summer, the Gravenstein Apple Fair team is committed to reducing waste and bringing awareness to best recycling practices within Sonoma County. The community event, being held on August 11 & 12 at Ragle Ranch Park in Sebastopol, is the annual fundraiser for Sonoma County Farm Trails.

We are seeking 6 small groups of volunteers who are enthusiastic and committed to reducing our carbon footprint. These groups will assist the public in diverting food scraps, compostable and recyclable items from going to the landfill. Volunteers will have the opportunity to engage with the public in a fun atmosphere, as well as make an immediate impact that benefits our environment.

**The group who diverts the most refuse from the landfill will win a \$400 cash prize\*.**

Each group will staff greening stations located throughout the fair. We encourage groups to participate both days of the fair (Aug. 11 & 12). Requested group size is between 4-12 people. Volunteers may choose to work 1 or 2 shifts a day (9:30am-6pm).

Volunteers will receive on-site training and support throughout the weekend to assist the public in sorting food waste, plastic, paper, etc.
