Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can people use credit cards to purchase tickets at the gate?

No credit cards at the gate. There is an ATM outside of GATE 1 and GATE 2 and one inside the fair close to Wine Tent. Credit cards will be accepted at the Country Store.

2. Do you accept checks at the gate?

Yes, made out to SCFT or Sonoma County Farm Trails and including a local phone number.

3. What is the cost of tickets?

\$15 for adults, \$12 for seniors and veterans, \$10 for children (ages 6-12); \$10 for bikers (with special ticket from bike parking area); kids 5 and under are free.

4. Do Ragle Road residents get in for free?

Neighbors should have received complimentary tickets. However, if someone didn't get a ticket, they can show their driver's license with a Ragle Road address for entry.

5. Are people allowed to go out of the event and come back in?

Yes, hands will be stamped at the entrances for re-entry.

6. Is there a "Will Call" area?

Yes, a Will Call station will be located at Gate 2, close to Dutton Ranch.

7. Is there parking for bikes?

There is a dedicated zone for bike parking which is staffed by volunteers, but it is not valet. We encourage bikers to use their locks and to park close together. Bikers receive a special ticket for discounted admission (\$10 for entry). Owners park their bikes at their own risk. Sonoma County Farm Trails is not responsible for lost or stolen bicycles.

8. Are dogs or other pets welcome at GAF?

Sorry, no pets at GAF- only certified service dogs are allowed on grounds. Please don't leave dogs in parked cars.

9. Is GAF 100% wheelchair accessible? How about restrooms?

We have special beach tire wheelchairs that can be checked out from the Farm Trails Info Booth. They are good for the rough terrain. We have two handicapped port-o-potties.

10. Will there be special Handicap parking spaces designated? If so, where?

Handicap parking is in the lot to the right (north) of the main entrance. Parking is free for cars with handicap plates.

11. Is parking free for cars?

There are two free shuttle buses that run all day during GAF hours to/from satellite parking lots at Holy Ghost Hall at 7960 Mill Station Rd. and O'Reilly Media at 1005 Gravenstein Highway. Premium on-site parking at Ragle Ranch Park is \$5 per day.

12. Are Regional Parks Passes valid for parking at Ragle during GAF?

Yes. If a car displays the Sonoma County Regional Parks Day Use Parking Pass, no fee will be collected for parking at Ragle.

13. Is the dog park open during GAF?

The dog park is open, but parking is not guaranteed. No dogs may enter GAF grounds unless they're certified service dogs. Regional Parks Pass must be displayed for free admission to parking zones.

14. Where do volunteers check in?

Volunteers should go to the Information Booth once inside the fair to get details for their shifts. If by chance they don't have their wristband or ticket, they must call or text the Information Booth or their Area Chair so someone can meet them at the gate.

15. Can people bring coolers with their own food and beverages into the event?

Small coolers for baby food and special needs are allowed. Absolutely no alcohol may be brought onto fair grounds by attendees.

16. Where are Emergency Services?

Gold Ridge Fire provides emergency services. Their fire truck is located just to the East of the fairgrounds, close to handicap parking lot. The Information Booth has a First Aid kit.

17. Where is the Information Booth?

The Info Booth is located in the center of the fair, north of Gate 2.

18. Where can people buy apples? What about apple juice?

Walker Apples is by Gate 1; Dutton Ranch is by Gate 2; & Kozlowski is close to Loading Zone 1. Cars can park in loading zones closest to the vendors to pick up apples on their way out. Manzana will be selling organic apple juice by the glass and bottle next to the Info Booth.

19. Are people allowed to bring glass bottles into the venue?

Yes, and we encourage folks to fill up water bottles at one of our two provided filtered water stations. One is close to the Information Booth; the other is near Cider Tent.

20. Will there be a breast feeding station/tent be available? What about diaper changing?

There's not a dedicated tent, but breast-feeding moms are welcome to nurse and rest in Willowist Miniature Horses' booth at Life on the Farm area. For diaper changes, there are plenty of straw bales ☺.

21. What is the protocol for lost children?

Any children that are separated from their parents should be taken immediately to the Information Booth, and we will radio all of our staff and crew to begin searching as top priority.
